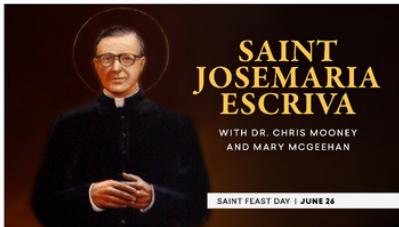

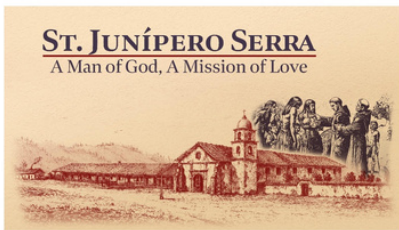

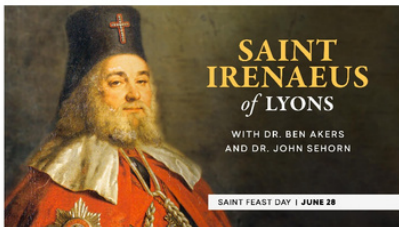
St. Josemaria Escriva | Catholic Saints
